### Before You Begin

- **Review your compatibility points.** Are your current systems, hardware, servers, or configurations compatible with the latest software?
- **Conduct a performance health check.** How is your current application working? Do you have any concerns before moving forward with your upgrade?
- Assess your backup strategy. Identify the how, where, and what you plan to do to back up your current applications.
- **Build your upgrade plan.** What do you want or need to accomplish with this upgrade?
- Review and update your plan. Share your plan with stakeholders or other key resources that will support this upgrade.
- Obtain an assessment of your plan. Work with your Information Builders representative to review and assess your upgrade plan before you begin.

### Fixed In Release 8.2.02

View some of the fixes, by product area, that are included in Release 8.2.02.

#### **Active Technologies**

• When running an AHTML chart, riser colors specified inside the GRAPH\_JS block of the referenced StyleSheet (for example, red, yellow, and blue) are not reflected in the chart output. Instead, riser colors are displayed in dark red, blue, and brown.

#### **Admin Console**

• The Shared Content folder name is not translated to Hebrew when the WebFOCUS Client code page and Dynamic Language Switch are configured for Hebrew and the user signs in with the Hebrew language.

#### App Studio

- When an HTML page references a resource on the Reporting Server, the /approot reference added an additional approot folder to the path.
- HTML pages lose the approot JavaScript file references after they are opened in App Studio.
- JAWS cannot read HTML pages created in the HTML canvas.
- In the Maintain Development Environment, when a maintain file is created with a check box control using the TextOnLeft property, and is then migrated to App Studio, the TextOnLeft property is not applied when a user runs the HTML file.
- Requests with an amper variable value are not passed onto the subsequent procedures, causing migrated HTML pages from 7.7x to fail at run time when saved in App Studio Release 8.2 Version 01M.
- The Page: Header corner property value is not retained for the Tab, Accordion, and Window components.
- In an OS/400 operating system, copying between two different servers corrupts the file.

#### **BI Portal**

- An error occurs when Dialogue Manager commands are added to an Alert test.
- The user cannot set the Border Style of a Tabbed container in the Portal Designer.
- A portal with collapsible banners does not load in a Microsoft Edge browser.

#### InfoAssist+

- The Data pane shortcut menu offers new bucket syntax aggregation option for legacy PFJ-based charts.
- A reference line cannot be added to a dual axis chart when the value is a computed field unless the computed field has a fix value.
- When creating a chart based on a HOLD file, the request fails.
- Preset formats for thousands formatting in legacy charts is now provided.
- Performance issue caused by multiple WHERE clauses.
- When using InfoMini with the Query pane set to either 1x4 or 2x2, the Query pane will now contain items to edit.

#### ReportCaster

- When the DSTLOG servlet is called with the IBIB\_jobdesc parameter, an HTTP 500 is returned by the application server.
- Configuring Secure Socket Layer (SSL) encryption in the ReportCaster Console results in a javax.net.ssl.SSLHandshakeException error message.

#### Security

- The X.509 certificate authentication is not working with Other Name, resulting in an exception error.
- The IBI\_SIGNIN\_PATHS is set to run a procedure on sign in, but is running if the Public access is enabled and the user either signed out of WebFOCUS or does not directly access the Sign-in page, but accesses it through the /ibi\_apps context.
- Upgrade Tika 1.14 from 1.13 to resolve vulnerability.
- Implement Spring Framework 3.2.18 in order to address known vulnerabilities under CVE-2014-3578 Directory Traversal in Spring Framework 4.0.0 to 4.0.4 and 3.20 to 3.2.8.
