

Before You Begin

When planning your upgrade, you should also consider the following:

- Consider your customizations. Do you have customized features, settings, or styling in your application?
- **Review your compatibility points.** Are your current systems, hardware, servers, or configurations compatible with the latest software?
- **Conduct a performance health check.** How is your current application working? Do you have any concerns before moving forward with your upgrade?
- Assess your backup strategy. Identify the how, where, and what you plan to do to back up your current applications.
- Build your upgrade plan. What do you want or need to accomplish with this upgrade?
- Review and update your plan. Share your plan with stakeholders or other key resources that will support this upgrade.
- Obtain an assessment of your plan. Work with your Information Builders representative to review and assess your upgrade plan before you begin.

View some of the fixes, by product area, that are included in Release 8206.

Administration Console

When editing the Excel Server URL or the Graph Server URL setting in the Administration Console, the previously visible, but incorrectly displayed, third list option no longer appears. (190123017)

Autoprompt

Using a mandatory filter defined in a synonym's Master File with ACCEPT=FOCEXEC does not show the values to select from in the sort order specified in the called focexec. The values are always listed in ascending order. (190124019)

ReportCaster

- When the WebFOCUS Client Dynamic Language option is configured and an existing schedule is edited and saved by a user signed in with a language different than the user who created the schedule, the schedule title becomes blank. (180517038)
- The reader task goes into an infinite loop when it encounters a schedule that has an invalid recurrence of zero minutes which causes the Distribution server to stop instead of recording the error and continuing to process schedules. (190209001)

Reporting

- Some fonts (such as Tahoma and Trebuchet MS) are not displayed properly in the Chrome internal viewer when running a PDF report against a Unicode Reporting Server. (180712063, 181024026, 181125001, 190228175, 190228043)
- When running an HTML report that includes SET BYDISPLAY=ACROSS or SET BYDISPLAY=ALL, styling color, borders, and two verb objects, the second verb object is not styled and the border is incomplete. (190108131)

Security

- The Home page sign out link is incorrect for KeyCloak or OpenID Connect security configurations. (181129199, 190206139, 190429065)
- User Licensing information for InfoAssist is incorrect for users assigned the InfoAssist privilege and are not assigned to a group authorized to access InfoAssist.

Adapters

- The Adapter for Presto[™] is a distributed SQL query engine designed to query large data sets.
- The Adapter for Slack[®] integrates WebFOCUS with business messaging applications.
- The Adapter for Db2 can now be configured to use JDBC, in addition to CLI and CAF.

Server

- Several enhancements have been made to the Web Console for this release.
- The new JSON-based SET CONNECTION_ATTRIBUTES_EXT command supports the "allow_data_load" parameter to allow the adapter connection to be available for Upload, Quick Copy, and Custom Copy.
- Setting the Connection parameter "auto_prompt": "y" will prompt for user credentials on running a procedure and upload.
- New JSON-based syntax has been implemented for setting connection attributes.
